



## Request for Applications for Documentary Film Producer

Disabled Human Rights Centre (DHRC-Nepal) was established in 2000 AD by a group of young disabled people from different corners realizing the real situation of PWDs in Nepal. They themselves are having some kinds of disability due to which they suffered in the context of obtaining education and employment opportunities. Since its beginning, DHRC has been persistently working towards achieving its mission through a wide range of activities.

Disabled Human Rights Center (DHRC), partnering with Ministry of Women, Children and Social Welfare and Department of Information has implemented a 3 year project named "Alleviating Poverty among Disable People in Nepal" from April 2014 to March 2017. This project is funded by UK Aid under its Global Poverty Alleviation Fund (GPAF) in collaboration with Disability and Development Partners (DDP), UK and four local partners namely, RECED (Tanahun), FHRD (Dang), DEC (Surkhet) and BRCD (Bardiya). The project was designed in a very collaborative and participative way by all partners, based on our shared working experience, and the real stories and felt experience of PwDs, including those who are facing extreme poverty. This lead to our hypothesis - or theory of change - that we believe changes in disabled people's lives and situations are best achieved by PwDs themselves, through their organisations (DPOs, self help and other groups) having ownership and involvement in the means of achieving change.

DHRC-Nepal wants to closely capture the behavior, skills and views of direct and indirect beneficiaries involved in the Global Poverty Alleviation Project (GPAF) in the mentioned project sites by providing

- ◆ Progress of the project,
- ◆ Audio record of interview with local community group as well as District level and VDC authorities regarding the effective planning and implementation of the projects, and
- ◆ Audio and visual records of interview with DHRC representatives and other Project partners.
